### CIC OXFORD READING TREE

Oxford Reading Tree stories at stages 1-4 feature settings and situation most children will find familiar. It reflects the experiences of most preschool children and their imagination.

Children of this age will readily identify with the characters and situations, as it helps them build their comprehension skills.

Each book tells a complete story, using natural language, phonically decodable words and high frequency words, all supported by funny and engaging pictures. The books offer plenty of scope for developing children's word recognition and language comprehension skills. Through application of systematic phonic teaching, children become highly motivated to put extra effort in learning to read.

Oxford Reading Tree stories at stages 5-9 continues to feature the familiar characters from previous stages in stories that reflect the experiences of most children.

The stories still use natural language, phonically decodable words and high frequency words, all illustrated with funny and engaging pictures. Reading them will enable children to practice different reading skills and continue to develop word recognition and language comprehension skills.

#### **SOUND STARTERS**

Sound starters are books to read and chant. They introduce the skill of associating letters and sounds (grapho-phonic knowledge). At the same time, there are books providing children with real stories to enjoy.

#### Sound Starters aims to:

- Encourage an enjoyment of language and a positive attitude to reading
- Help children link the sounds of English with their common letter equivalents using a 'multi-sensory' approach
- Develop essential reading behaviours such as learning the order and direction in which stories are read
- Encourage children to use illustrations as a prompt for telling a story
- Give opportunities for reading repeated texts

#### **SOUND RHYMES**

Sound Rhymes will help the beginner reader consolidat early reading skills. The stories focus on important letter and sound patterns for reading and spelling. The stories in this series are meaningful and amusing, and each of it focuses on particular rhyming families. Children learn to associate the sounds of the rhyme with a particular letter pattern.



#### Sound Rhymes series aims to:

- Increase children's awareness of rhymes
- Provide opportunities to recognize and read words based on the familiar lettersound patterns of rhymes
- Extend children's oral language and encourage them to move beyond the printed text
- Encourage an enjoyment of language and a positive attitude to reading
- Develop the recognition of high frequency words within a meaningful context
- Encourage children to focus on the print to aid word recognition and self correction

#### **SOUND BLENDS**

Sound blends help the beginner reader consolidate early reading skills. The stories focus on initial consonant blends, a blend consisting of a sequence of two or more consonants in the spoken word.

- Encourage an enjoyment of language and a positive attitude to reading
- Develop the recognition of high frequency words within a meaningful context
- Encourage children to focus on the print to aid word recognition and self correction
- Give opportunities to practice decoding words based on the familiar letter/sound patterns of blends
- Extend children's oral language and encourage them to move beyond the printed text

#### **SOUND STORIES**

Sound Stories introduce children to 'reading' first books. They reinforce the skill of associating letters and sounds (grapho-phonic knowledge) within the context of meaningful stories that can be enjoyed and shared.

#### The Sound Stories series aims to:

- Encourage an enjoyment of language and a positive attitude to reading
- Reinforce and consolidate the important link between the sounds of English and their common letterequivalent and toward using this knowledge in working out new words
- Extend children's oral language and encourage them to move beyond the printed text


